History of the Gagnon Scholarship

A gift from deceased parish member Cecile Cameron, in memory of her brothers Theodore Gagnon, Leonard Gagnon, and Gerry Gagnon, has enabled St. Michael's Church to establish a scholarship fund to assist parish members of all ages in obtaining education beyond high school. Ms. Cameron had a strong belief in the importance of education; she did not specify that her gift be used to fund any particular vocation, or profession or type of school.

Only the income from Ms. Cameron's gift will be used to fund these scholarships. Therefore, the amount of money awarded in any year may differ from that awarded other years. Those who were awarded the Gagnon Scholarship last year are eligible to apply again this year. However, there is not a guarantee of a continued scholarship.

History of the Perrault Scholarship

Fran and Ted Perrault were parishioners at St. Michael's Parish for over 50 years. They were part of many organizations of St. Michael's. Fran was involved in education as a kindergarten teacher in the Duluth Public Schools. Ted worked for Minnesota Power and Light. They both valued education and wanted to give back something to the St. Michael's community. Their hope is that this scholarship will play a role in enriching the lives of its recipients, both in their endeavors for higher education and in their spiritual life.

Eligibility

Who is eligible? Any St. Michael's parishioner planning to attend a post-secondary institution for the 2013-2014 academic year.

Financial need will not be a factor in the selection process.

Non-traditional students are encouraged to apply.

Application

The St. Michael's Church Gagnon Scholarship may be just the opportunity you've been waiting for- the opportunity to continue your education with a little bit of extra cash! If you have plans for post-secondary education in the fall of 2013, perhaps you should consider applying for this scholarship.

Completed applications (and all reference letters, transcripts, and acceptance letters) must be received at the church office by 4:00 PM on Friday, April 5, 2013. *Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.*
